The resource is a short video interview with Adam Cawley, a chemist and scientist from the Royal Australian Chemical Institute, that investigates how to improve the drug testing of athletes.

The interview is broken into several sections: science, drug use and drug testing, and each section of the interview has two starter questions for students to think about and answer whilst watching the interview.
